AMETI Eastern Busway

Major road layout change on Pakuranga Road (between Panmure Bridge and Ti Rakau Drive)

Dear Residents,

We are writing to advise that from 20 July until late 2020, there will be a significant change to the layout of Pakuranga Road between Panmure Bridge and Ti Rakau Drive. This is part of the AMETI Eastern Busway project – a dedicated rapid transit busway that will improve journey times and provide greater travel choice for people in East Auckland.

What's happening?

To allow us to carry out major work to rebuild part of the road, we will be temporarily diverting eastbound traffic (Pakuranga bound) onto the newly paved busway running alongside the existing road. Clear signs will be in place but we ask everyone to take care and look out for them. The map and information on the other side of this letter has more detailed information about the road layout and turning restrictions.

How will you be affected?

- From 20 July until late 2020, there will be a new road layout on Pakuranga Road between Panmure Bridge and Ti Rakau Drive. This will result in a number of turning restrictions on side streets.
- Consented hours of work are 7.30am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, with crews permitted to arrive/set up and pack up/exit outside of these hours. We will update you prior to any night work that may be required.
- Noise and vibration generated by this work will be within the limits that are set as part of the approved construction work site plan.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained with safety measures in place.

All construction work areas will be cordoned off. Please discuss this work with family, in particular children to ensure their safety.

Turning restrictions (please see map for further details)

A SLIP LANE TURNING EAST BOUND

- Motorists will be unable to turn right out of the Pakuranga Road slip lane next to Panmure Bridge.
 - If you need to travel east from this slip lane, we recommend turning around on Church Crescent.





B MILLEN AND LATHAM AVENUE TURNING EAST BOUND

- Motorists will be unable to turn right into or out of Millen Avenue and Latham Avenue while work takes place between 20 July and late 2020.
 - If you need to travel east towards Pakuranga Town Centre from Millen Avenue or Latham Avenue then you are able to turn left out of these streets and turn around at Kerswill Avenue or Church Crescent.
 - If you are travelling east towards Pakuranga and need to turn into Millen Avenue then you are able to turn around on Pakuranga Road, at the Williams Ave intersection.
 - If you need to turn into Latham Avenue when travelling east towards Pakuranga, you will need to find a safe turning point further east on Pakuranga Road.

Personalised Journey Plan

As a resident of this area, we appreciate that you are likely to be impacted by some of the changes being made to the road layout and the turning restrictions. We have included more information on the maps provided.

If you think it may be easier for you to take public transport rather than drive to work, school or shopping trips (particulary for trips into and out of Millen and Latham Avenues), you can apply for a FREE two week trial AT HOP card.
