The Shed... a Saint Kentigern food distribution centre

In response to financial hardship caused by Covid-19, we as the Saint Kentigern community have an opportunity to help some of the schools in our own backyard who have families in need.



'The Shed' is a newly refurbished space on the College campus that has been transformed into a food distribution centre. Our vision is to act as a conduit storing and providing food parcels for families in need at schools that Saint Kentigern partners with. The schools will distribute within their spheres of influence using their own guidelines/criteria. 'The Shed' will be the conduit between the resources and generosity of the Saint Kentigern community and these school communities. Interested Saint Kentigern students, staff and parents will be involved in providing, stacking, packaging and perhaps transporting food; but will not be involved in its distribution to families.
