Following on from the communication from David Hodge, Head of Saint Kentigern, in acknowledgement of the time and effort parents had to put into supporting their children during the Lockdown, Saint Kentigern is offering a free holiday programme in Week 3 of the July holiday break. Below is more information regarding the different programmes.

Year 7-10 Activity Programme

Year 7-10 students who are coming into Saint Kentigern College are required to select one full day option and will remain in that option for the entire day. They will not be able to switch and change options on the day. There will be no food available for purchase on site and students will not be able to leave the school grounds during the day.

- **General Activities:** This may include cooking, art, fashion design, film and media
- **Netball Academy:** This will be a one-day program designed to develop students' skills, game play and fitness.
- **Football Academy:** This will be a one-day program designed to develop students' skills, game play and fitness.
- **Rugby Academy:** This will be a one-day program designed to develop students' skills, game play and fitness.
- **K Rock:** This will be a three-day course that allows students to play, write and record songs by themselves or with each other, utilizing the studios upstairs in the Music Centre
- **Performing Arts:** This may include dance, drama, and musical theatre
- **Sports Games:** This will include a range of different sports and games throughout the week

Year 11-13 Work Ready & Study Programme

The activity program is designed to support students with work-ready skills and to provide further opportunities to progress and develop NCEA portfolio subjects. Senior students are not required to stay at school for the entire day, unless the course requires their attendance.

- **Advanced Workplace First Aid :** Students can achieve first aid qualification. NCEA Level 3 unit standard credits are awarded for this course upon successful completion. Some pre-reading is required before the start of the course.
- **C.V. and Cover Letter Writing:** Students will have the opportunity to work with an outside specialist to develop skills around creating C. V's and cover letters to support employment and other future opportunities.
- **Financial Literacy:** Students will learn strategies to manage their personal finances and credit. NCEA Level 3 unit standard credits are also available as a result of successful completion of this course.
