College Student Reports and Subject Learning Conferences

Subject reports for Year 7-13 students will be available to view **from Thursday 3 June**. These reports provide an overview of the student's progress this year to date. Following on from these, parents of Years 7-13 will have an opportunity to meet their child's teachers at a **Learning Conference on Thursday 10 June**.

We encourage a Learning Conference rather than a Parent/Teacher Interview to help promote a learning partnership. Where appropriate, we also encourage students to attend as both parents and staff have found that this encourages, shared decision-making, stronger communication, and clearer learning expectations.

This Term **Learning Conferences will be held on Thursday June 10 from 2 pm until 9 pm**. **Bookings for these conferences will be open on Thursday 3 June**, the same day the reports go live on the OLE.

With the Conferences starting at 2pm, this means school will finish at 1pm. Saint Kentigern buses have been organised to come from 1pm and late buses will still be offered at 5pm. On this day, Kents and Saints Cafes will open for morning tea but **not** for lunch. Students who are under 14 years and need temporary supervision on the afternoon are welcome to stay in the Lower Goodfellow Centre next to Student Futures but please register their attendance **before Tuesday 8 June with Liz Jones at liz.jones@saintkentigern.com**

The Subject Learning Conferences will be held in EMC for Year 7 and the majority of Year 8-13 conferences will be held across the Goodfellow and Macky classrooms. Therefore, please dress warmly as you will need to travel between buildings.

Subject conferences for Years 7 are 10mins in length while Years 8-13 are 6mins in length. It is very important that everyone adheres to these times. If you wish to have a longer discussion, please contact the subject teacher directly to make another time on a later date.
