Dear Parents, Caregivers and Students

I know we will all be pleased with the announcement of moving to level 2 as of tomorrow. School will resume as normal for all students (Day 1 timetable as Athletics has been postponed) and buses will be running as per normal times and routes. The school cafés will be open.

- If you have been told to self-isolate, you must do so immediately.
- Keep a track of where you have been and who you have seen.

At Alert Level 2 schools are open for students to attend and it is safe to do so. We will be expecting all students to attend school other than those who have been told to self-isolate, or who have a medical condition that requires them to remain at home to continue with distance learning. - Year 13 students will not be able to leave campus during study or lunchtime during level 2.
- Face masks are not required, and we prefer that they are not worn, however if it makes you feel safe, it is okay to wear one.
