Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Welcome to 2022. In preparation for start of school on **Tuesday 1 February** I would like to update the first day and Covid-19 information. Clearly, with the move to RED Traffic Light setting, our programmes will be impacted. As most of you will be aware all students and staff must wear a face mask while at school and travelling to and from school when on school buses. If your child is unwell please do not allow them to attend school. Unfortunately, due to the RED Covid restrictions this event has been postponed to a later date.

Covid Update

- Classroom ventilation air purification. Saint Kentigern follows Ministry of Education guidelines on ventilation. We are in a fortunate position to have natural ventilation in our classrooms, supported by either centralised air or heat pumps to assist. Should the Ministry of Education provide guidance on air purification systems we would follow the MoE approved models and guidance.
- Additional cleaning of student bathrooms during the day, and on high touch surfaces such as door handles and stairwell bars continues to take place.
- Masks are compulsory inside and outside (unless eating or exercising) and on school transport.

- We ask you to remind your child to follow good hygiene practices, including regular hand washing, (hand sanitiser is also available in classrooms) and any random coughs or sneezes into elbows.
- Vaccinations please provide your child's vaccination status updates to the College Health Centre, health@saintkentigern.com, while vaccinations are not mandated for children the information assists to provide information for the MoE should there be a case amongst our community, and for planning programmes. This information is held as private only available to the Health Centre, and Senior Leadership Team.
- We have a high vaccination rate of our students at Saint Kentigern College which provides some protection to them and those around them.
- If your child is sick please do not send them to school. You will be requested to collect them from school if they arrive unwell. This includes minor cold symptoms which cannot be distinguished from some Covid symptoms. Please contact Healthline and have your child tested if they have Covid symptoms. Current guidelines are to have them remain home until a negative test result is received and they are symptom free.

Saints and Kents Cafés

Our student cafés will be open. Covid guidelines will be applied to limit the number of students in the café at a time. Pre-ordering of lunches online by 1pm the day prior will commence from Day 2 onwards, which will allow pick up takeaway style.

On **Friday 4 February** students must be in their Formal Uniforms to have their individual portrait photos taken. Students must be well groomed, boys clean shaven and girls with correct earrings (plain studs).

NCEA & IB Results
