Dear Parents and Caregivers

Re: An exciting new Saint Kentigern College Service & Technology Faculty initiative - The Tiny House Project 2024

In 2024 we are introducing a new Technology project for our **Year 13 Building and Construction Class,** namely, the construction of a **Tiny House** that will eventually be gifted to needy (yet to be determined) recipients in Northland. The project is an excellent opportunity for the "service to others" component of our Saint Kentigern Mission Statement to be infused into and outworked within a formal curriculum setting.

As we want to 'gift' the completed building, we are hoping to fund the project through the generosity of our Saint Kentigern community.

What do we require?

Draughts person

Our immediate need is for a draughts person willing to donate their time to draw up the plans and take off (quantities) for a small freestanding building (17sqm) which will sit on piles, or a subfloor on a trailer. Ideally, we would like this completed by mid-December.

- Maximum dimensions (5900L x 2900W x 2800H).
- Single pitched corrugated iron roof.
- Timber construction, plasterboard interior, panel exterior (possibly board & batten cladding).
- Windows on three walls & a ranch slider.
- One internal wall with cavity slider.
- Potential for shower and toilet.
- Guttering & fascia board.
- Kitchenette.
- Decking on one side (attachable).

Tradespeople

- Builder: willing to advise on consent vs non-consent options, and to give periodic advice on an ongoing basis.
- Plumber: willing to advise on plumbing requirements and give practical assistance as required.
- Electrician: willing to advise on electrical requirements and to give practical assistance as required.



Donations of building materials (or financial donations / sponsorship):

- Framing, building paper, insulation, cladding (to be determined).
- Corrugated iron.
- Guttering & fascia board.
- Aluminium joinery: 3 x windows, ranch slider.
- Electrical: wiring, lights, plugs, Switchboard.
- Plumbing: toilet, shower (pipes & fittings).
- Kitchenette (flat pack).
- Decking timber.
- Tools: DeWalt battery power tools (details can be made available).
