## ONE OUT, ALL OUT

#### ONE BUILDING OUT, ALL BUILDINGS OUT - IN AN EVACUATION

When we evacuate any building at the College, ALL BUILDINGS are EVACUATED as many of our buildings are clustered close to each other

• The most common reason for an evacuation is a fire alert.





### **EVACUATION SIGNAL**

#### WHAT TO LISTEN FOR

The continuous ringing of bells, or siren, or in some buildings a voice over alarm.





### EXIT THE BUILDING/AREA IMMEDIATELY

#### AS SOON AS YOU IDENTIFY IT IS AN EVACUATION

- Exit and go to the safe assembly point
- Don't go into buildings to gather up your belongings
- If your bag is next to you, you may take it so long as it doesn't inhibit your (or others) safe movement or slow you down from getting out of the building





## GO TO THE EVACUATION ASSEMBLY POINT

#### THE FIELD OPPOSITE EMC, ADJACENT TO T-BLOCK

- Walk calmly
- Walk around buildings using the road footpaths not through buildings, not directly alongside buildings.
  - We want to avoid queues of people fitting in small spaces
  - We want everyone to be aware of scenarios like a window exploding outward to think about how far is safe from buildings
  - It may mean taking the long way by using roads better to be safe than rush.

#### ON THE FIELD

- Keep voices down
- Follow the instructions of teachers
  - You may be asked to line up by Tutor Group & House
  - Roll call is not required Building Wardens (staff trained) check buildings to ensure no one is inside.
  - Remain on the field until you are given instruction otherwise
  - Dependent on the emergency, and the time it takes to confirm everyone is gathered, the time on the field will vary





## WHAT IF IT IS RAINING

# YOU STILL NEED TO ASSEMBLE ON THE EVACUATION FIELD

- Building Wardens and teachers won't necessarily know what and where the emergency is at the time everyone is assembling
- We need to be able to communicate to everyone
- If the site manager advises it is safe to move and assemble in the Gyms to shelter from the rain, then you will be given instruction to move to the Gyms and assemble in House areas.
- Until such a time, you need to assemble on the field
